

What is AI?



- Artificial Intelligence is the simulation of human intelligence in machines that are programmed to think and work like humans.
- Al can be classified into three categories - Artificial Narrow Intelligence(A.N.I.), Artificial General Intelligence(A.G.I.), and Artificial Superintelligence(A.S.I.)
- All is being used in various fields such as healthcare, finance, transportation, and many more.





What is AI?




- In the context of the Dynamics ecosystem, AI is a learning model that leverages data from inside and outside your organization to help you with everyday tasks, like having a team of assistants that are experts in many different areas.
- The AI understands the Office suite, and line of business applications that you're already using.

What is Microsoft Copilot?



- Microsoft Copilot is an Alpowered assistant to help you with common Office tasks
- Copilot provides suggestions, assistance, and can even write apps and automations
- Copilot is integrated with Office 365, Business Central, Dynamics 365 (CRM), and many other tools





How can Copilot help with everyday office tasks?



- Copilot can help with common Office tasks such as formatting, formula entry, and data entry
- It can provide suggestions, assistance, and write apps and automations to streamline workflows
- Copilot can help with tasks across Office 365, Dynamics 365, and many other tools




How can Copilot help with everyday office tasks?



- Copilot can help you review documents, meetings, and business data
- Copilot is optionally integrated into your Microsoft Tenant, and can securely use information you share with it to answer questions and make decisions



Copilot in Office 365



- Copilot runs within Excel, Word, Teams, and other applications with context-aware suggestions and assistance.
- It can review and summarize meetings, help with Excel functions, drafting documents, and many other common tasks



Copilot in Business Central



- Copilot can analyze lists such as invoices, purchases, customers, etc and allows you to "ask questions" of your data
- Copilot can suggest inventory descriptions, match transactions, and find patterns
- BC support is always expanding and in preview





Copilot in Dynamics 365 (CRM)




- Copilot can summarize the timeline to bring staff "up to speed" on emails, opportunities, recent cases, and other CRMbased entities
- Copilot can directly query your data and answer naturallanguage questions based on the information you give it access to





Copilot in PowerApps / PowerAutomate



- Copilot can be used in PowerApps to do things like reading and data-entering invoices, process forms and turn them into tables
- Copilot can be used to build automations – you describe what you want, and it will build a simple automation that you can then customize



What about Dynamics GP?



- With SmartLists and integration to Excel, you can use Copilot to analyze and query your data from GP, and also build automations to and from the Dynamics GP environment.
- With On-Premise connectors, SQL data can be used to feed Copilot and make it part of the full ecosystem





Benefits of Copilot



- Copilot provides more seamless integration between your LOB applications (BC, GP, CRM, Teams, Office, etc) and gives you options to use, understand, analyze and report on data you already have.
- Copilot is your assistant and expert, built-in to the Microsoft Dynamics ecosystem



Benefits of Copilot



- Microsoft has invested heavily in Al, and continues to build new features and functionality into the applications you already own and use
- Many functions are free, and some are add-on for additional functionality
